

What to Expect in a Semester


Typical Components of a Module:


- Most 1.0 CU modules will have 3 hours' worth of seminar lesson every week

WHAT IS BOSS? SMU BIDDING ONLINE SYSTEM (BOSS)

- A bidding system for SMU undergraduate students that allows you to enrol for classes.
- Students are given <u>e-dollars (e\$)</u> to bid for modules and the system enrols the highest bidders into each class. •
 - Multiple rounds and windows
 - Minimum bid amount is e\$10
 - A ballot will be done in the event of a tie-breaker where there is one last seat left.

FOR FRESHMEN ONLY!

- Certain modules are pre-assigned to freshmen based on the basket that they are randomly allocated to (Refer to "Pre-assigned Modules")
- Depending on one's academic planning, most freshmen would bid for 1 or 2 additional modules **OR** do not bid for any additional modules during Year 1.



WHAT IS BOSS? **BIDDING CREDITS (e\$)**

Effective from AY 2024/25:

- All students will receive e\$115 per semester, regardless of the number of modules you are required to take. •
- Bonus bidding credits (from Term 2 onwards): ٠
 - e\$10 for End-of Term Course Feedback
 - e\$5 for SMUSA Student Survey (SSS)
 - e\$3 for Student Pulse Survey (SPS)

In total, students can get allocated up to e\$133 per semester upon completion of all the surveys!

• Any unused e\$ will be carried over to the subsequent terms, with the exception of Term 3 (Summer Term).

FOR FRESHMEN ONLY!

- All Freshmen will still receive e\$100 in their first term, as they have not done any feedback.
- The above allocation of e\$ will be applicable to them from Term 2 onwards.



WHAT IS BOSS? PRE-ASSIGNED MODULES

- Freshmen are randomly divided into 2 baskets for pre-assigned modules.
- They are not allowed to drop any pre-assigned modules (i.e. you cannot choose your professors /timings for your pre-assigned modules).
- e\$20 will be deducted per pre-assigned course.

<u>Pre-assigned modules for all BAcc Freshmen:</u>

- In Year 1: ACCT111 Financial Accounting (FA) in Term 1 and ACCT112 Management Accounting (MA) in Term 2.
- In Year 2: ACCT223 Taxation and ACCT224 Financial Analysis and Reporting (FRA)



WHAT IS BOSS? **PRE-ASSIGNED MODULES**

[NEW] MUTUAL CLASS SWAP

Effective from AY 2024/25:

- Students may apply to swap their pre-assigned course(s) section of the same course but with a different date and/or timing during the swap window before the start of course bidding exercise.
- Students can choose a maximum of 2 choices during the Swap Pre-assignment window before the start of Round 1 bidding.
- All the class swap requests are done anonymously and will go through processing to find an exact match.

WHAT IS BOSS? EXEMPTIONS

- Not all freshmen will be pre-assigned 4 modules per term due to exemptions.

MISCELLANEOUS ENROLLING FOR ADDITIONAL MODULE

Students may choose to take an additional module (i.e. enrol in the 6th course/course unit) if they are able to • manage the workload

Requirements:

- Cumulative GPA ≥ 3.30 after first year of study.
- Maximum of 6.5 CUs only.

How to Apply:

- 1. Fill up the "Application for Term Unit Load Increase" form online via OASIS > BOSS Bidding > Term Info.
 - To be submitted online within a week from the start of term
- 2. Once approved, you can bid for a 6th module in **Round 2A ONLY**.
- * Note that there will be <u>no additional e</u> allocated for bidding of the additional module

MISCELLANEOUS BIDDING STRATEGIES

Drop If Course Exceeds (DICE)

- Students can bid for additional modules beyond their term enrolment limit, but excess modules will be automatically dropped in order of preference.
- Cannot use DICE to bid for another class of the same module, or another module with a conflicting timetable/exam clash.

Sniping

- Riskier strategy where you drop a successful bid and re-bid again at a lower price, typically done a few minutes before the window closes.
- Usually done to save e-credits when you have over-bidded on a modules.

**NOTE: There is always a risk of being counter-sniped by other students.

Counter-Sniping

- Continuously refreshing the page when the bidding round is about to close, and bidding on a module if there is a sudden increase in class vacancies, due to other snipers dropping the module.
- It is also a riskier strategy

MISCELLANEOUS GENERAL Q&A

If I bid earlier for the course, does that affect my chances of getting a successful bid?

- If you are referring to bidding earlier:
 - WITHIN each round & window → then the timing in which you bid does not matter.
 - **BETWEEN** rounds and windows (e.g. bidding in Round 1 as opposed to Round 2) \rightarrow the available vacancies of a course in Round 1 is most likely higher than Round 2, which means you are more likely to be successful bidding for the same class in Round 1 than in Round 2.

Since there are already pre-assigned modules, what modules do students usually bid for?

- Many freshmen choose to take Introductory Statistics in their first year since it is a pre-requisite to several modules in their coursework.
- Other modules include SMU Core Modules in the Capabilities and Communities basket, as Accounting Core Modules tend to have a prerequisite of passing ACCT111, which you will take in your first semester.
- Following that, in Y1S2, you can choose to take Accounting Core Modules. You can refer to the Course Sequence provided in BOSS which offers suggested terms in which you can take certain modules, or you can check out ASoc's Module Difficulty Guidebook for student surveyed responses as well!

Where can I check the pre-requisites and co-requisites for certain courses?

- You can refer to the Course Outline for the relevant courses.
- Alternatively, you can visit ASoc's Module Difficulty Guidebook that has a mindmap of the pre-requisite and co-requisite relationships between modules.

MISCELLANEOUS GENERAL Q&A

Are Singapore Studies and Asia Studies counted to Global Exposure?

No, they are of <u>separate requirements</u>.

- Global Exposure is cleared by going on exchange or participating in certain overseas programs (e.g. study missions). These programs are typically publicised via email and will disclose if it counts towards clearing Global Exposure.
- For Singapore Studies and Asia Studies, students will automatically clear these requirements by passing Big Questions and Economics & Society.

What do the numbers in the course code signify? (e.g. Does ACCT1XX mean we should take it in Year 1, and ACCT2XX mean we should take it in Year 2?)

- Generally, the course code signifies course progression. Modules such as ACCT111 tend to be pre-requisites for modules such as ACCT221 or ACCT224. Similarly, modules like ACCT221 and ACCT224 tend to be pre-requisites for ACCT3XX. Modules with ACCT4XX tend to be accounting electives. However, there may be exceptions to this generalisation.
- This guideline is largely applicable to modules offered by Schools (other examples include FNCE, MGMT, etc). For SMU Core Modules, this guideline is generally not applicable.

MISCELLANEOUS GENERAL Q&A

Does the decimal point matter in bidding?

- Based on personal experience, the decimal points definitely matters
- You can choose your bids symbolically too!


What happens when we run out of credits?

- Although it goes without saying to conserve where you can, based on experiences shared previously by other students, some seniors have directly emailed SMU due to extenuating circumstances (e.g. it may delay their graduation if they are unable to take this module).
- Even though we are unable to speak on SMU's behalf as to criteria they use to give students this concession, it is worth a shot to email SMU if you are facing similar extenuating circumstances.








